

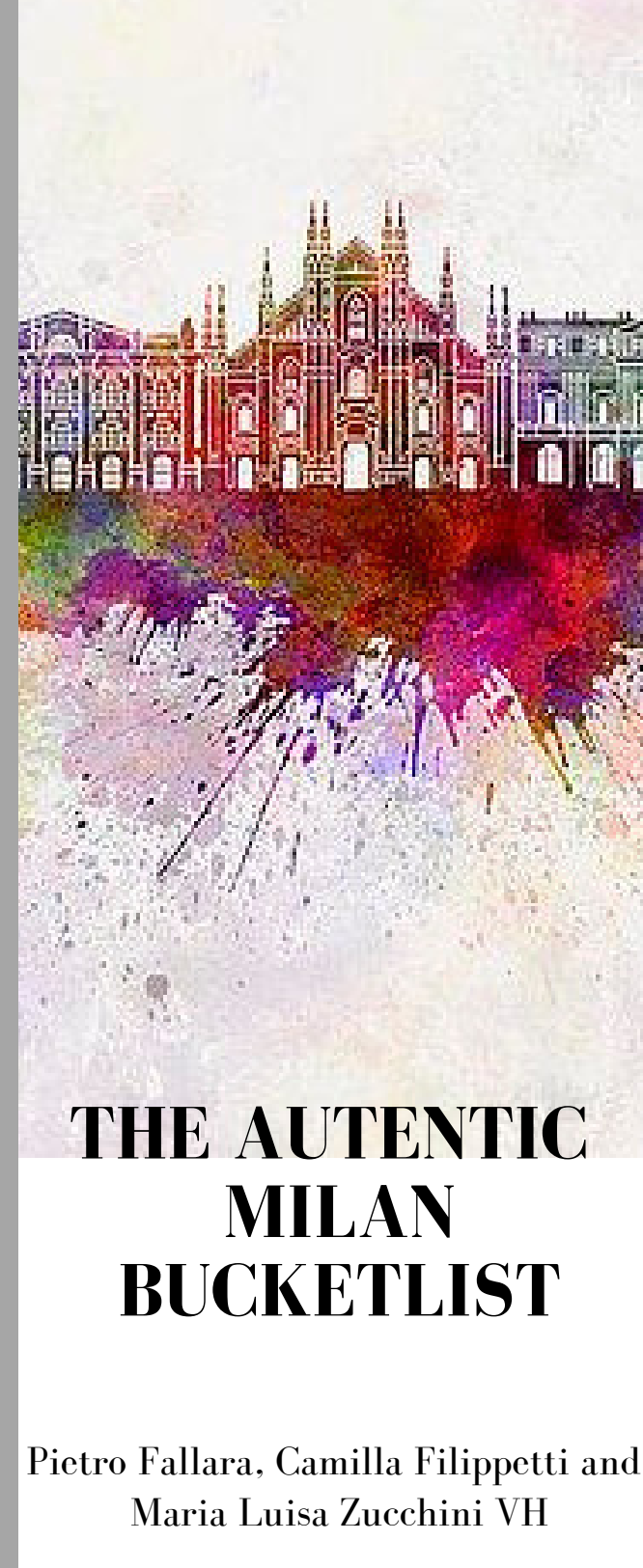
NAVIGLI BIKE TOUR

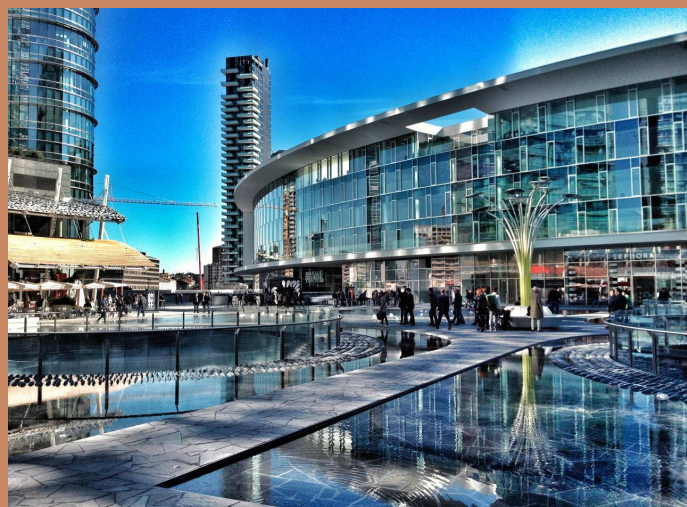
HISTORICAL TRAM

MODERN ARCHITECTURE

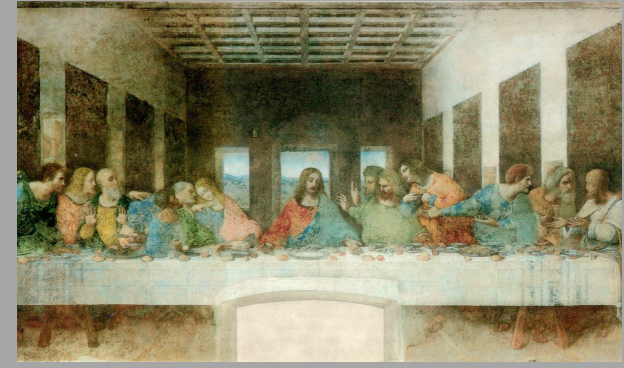
Milan is constantly growing and changing its skyline. If you want to experience the more dynamic side of the city, we suggest a walk around piazza Gae Aulenti and City Life.
